2ND NATIONAL T20 CRICKET CHAMPIONSHIP OF THE DEAF

Gymkhana Ground, Secunderabad : May 17 to 23, 2016

All India Sports Council of the Deaf is a National Sports Federation dealing with Multiple Sports & Games for the Deaf in all age groups in the country duly recognized by International Committee of Sports for the Deaf. AISCD is able to strengthen the game of Cricket for the Deaf more effectively and to open more opportunities for able deaf cricketers.

On popular demand from cricketers to hold National T20 Cricket Championship of the Deaf periodically, AISCD allotted the 2nd National T20 Cricket Championship of the Deaf to the Telangana Sports Council of the Deaf, Hyderabad again. TSCD is a rechristened organization from the erstwhile one under the banner - AP Sports Council of the Deaf, Hyderabad which is formed after bifurcation of the State of Andhra Pradesh into Andhra & Telangana in 2014. This Organization played host to the Inaugural National Deaf T20 Cricket Championship in 2013 successfully.

As scheduled the **2nd National T20 Cricket Championship of the Deaf** was conducted at CNR, Bandlaquda Hiyath Nagar, Hyderabad (distance of 12 Km from Secunderabad) / Gymkhana Ground, Secunderabad with Telangana Sports Council of the Deaf (TSCD), Hyderabad as Hosts in collaboration with Deaf Cricket Association (DCA), Hyderabad and also Hyderabad Cricket Association (HCA) on May, 17- 23, 2016. The Strength of participating state Teams in the Championship has been increased from fifteen (15) in 2013 to nineteen (19) in 2016.

The fixture of teams has been drawn into four pools, which played it out on a League-cum-Knockout basis from May 18 to 20, 2016. The top four teams from each pool made the semi-finals grade on May 21, 2016. The event concluded on May 22, 2016. All the matches were simultaneously held at CNRs ☐ve surf pitches/grass grounds, Badlaguda, Hiyath Nagar, Hyderabad and then Gymkhana Surf pitch/Grass ground, Secunderabad.
