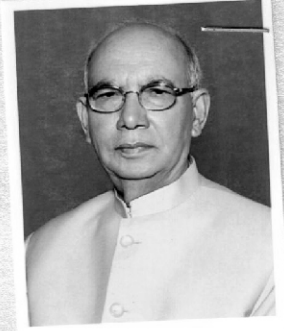

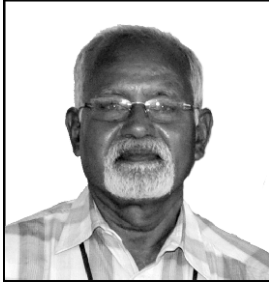

### PERFORMANCE-CUM- ACHIEVEMENT REPORT

The last National Games of the Deaf was conducted at Shiv Chhatrapati Sports University Complex, Balewadi, Pune, Maharashtra State on December 19 to 23, 1998. After that, we were not able to conduct it for about 15 consecutive years, perhaps because of AISCD's fault, which was beyond our control. And, with the motivated efforts of AISCD as well as the combined team work of those who love and treat deaf sports persons. We were able to organize and conduct the XVIII National Games of the Deaf successfully at Sree Kanteerava Stadium, Kasturba Road, Bangalore from 25<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup>, April 2013. The competitions were held mostly at the picture square sports premises of Sree Kanteerava Stadium which provided & required facilities for better performance by the athletes.

At the initial set up, we faced much hardship to organize it due to the activities of rebel organisations and also prevention of stadia, Government aid, etc by them but with the determination and devotion on the part of all concerned, the hosts, Karnataka Sports Federation of the Deaf and the Organising Committee formed under it was able to achieve our long pending aim. Our request to the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports to release funds for the above is still pending in the "deaf ears" but we hope they will open it and release funds. With the help and support of many public and private limited concerns, it came to a great success.

The Inauguration Ceremony was conducted on April 25, 2013 in the evening in a very attractive manner and the march past of athletes under AISCD banners, representing 19 state units under their respective state flags was conducted very well. Sri. Govinda Raju, President, Karnataka Olympic Association declared the National Games Open and he has witnessed the ceremony with much intention. Sri. A. K. Monappa, IAS, Managing Director, The Hutti Gold Mines Co. Ltd. And Sri. S. R. Srinivas Murthy, Educationist & Resource Person attended as other guest. Mr. Mr. Nanda Kumar K, General Secretary, Karnataka Volleyball Association & Joint Secretary, Volleyball Federation of India presided the Games.

We are proud to say that among the 20 affiliated state units, 19 were and other one unaffiliated state unit i.e. Chhattarsigh. Rajasthan State Unit did not turn up at Bengaluru for its own reasons.

Competitions in all the disciplines were tough and with the required standard. Regular exposures to International Competitions have motivated our Sports Persons to keep on improving up their performance. It was heartening to see Juniors & Sub Juniors of yesterdays taking part in the Championship as Seniors and Juniors respectively. By hard labour and determination, they have kept their "SPORTS CAREER" intact and are expected to keep on improving and be International Sports Persons of To-morrow. Their tire st with destiny continues in hope of coming to

International lime -light. Events in each discipline of Sports of the Championship were well managed by qualified and experienced officials of Karnataka Association of discipline concerned.

**ATHLETICS** Athletics still continue to draw large number of competitors as it covers six age groups and has sixty events. India's medal winning events are track middle and long distance running, Triple Jump and Long Jump along with Javelin and Hammer Throws. We have to say with proud that many new talents have been spotted in these events and we hope that with more exposure to National Competitions they are most likely to achieve high standard of performance which is essential for winning medals from International Competitions.

Three new India Records and one new Meet Record were created. Men senior group led the record breaking with New Meet Record and Junior Girls with new Meet Record. Sub Junior events were dropped down, with the instinct with more advanced training to develop their existing standards. Due to the unlawful deeds of the rebel group by objecting the planned National Games of the Deaf during February 2013 at New Delhi, the entry of Juniors and Sub Juniors were not done to the satisfying standard which was beyond our control.

We are sure that the performance of young generations is suitable to cope with international standards and sometimes near to Deaflympics records which may help them to win medals in forthcoming Deaflympics, Sofia, Bulgaria this year and also at the Asia Pacific Games of the Deaf.

**BADMINTION**: It was proven that the players of Badminton in National Games of the Deaf kept their standard at International level. Several new talents in both Women and Men section were spotted out which will surely be promises for the future.

**BASKETBALL**: It is observed that the basketball competitions are coming to the national standards. It was introduced in XV National Games of the Deaf and now it is flourishing. We are confident that they can compete at international level.

**FOOTBALL**: Football continued to be the second most popular discipline of sports among the Deaf. We already have exposure to International Competition by taking part in qualifying Round Match of Deaflympics. Our football players have kept on improving upon the standard of play. Further improvement in skill and stamina will definitely help India to reach Final Round Matches of Deaflympics in future.

**SWIMMING**: There has been considerable improvement in performance of our winner's men and we hope that by the year 2013 our winners will achieve International Standard for which we have been waiting for a long time.

**TABLE TENNIS**: In Table Tennis, we had best International performance since 1985, when we won Bronze Medal in Men's Team Game. Thereafter, we had to content with insignificant placing. But now once again, we have spotted talented players both men and women who can with morale and material support win back the World Ranking we once had enjoyed.

In Women's section, we also made considerable progress and if the trend continues we will have a Competent National Team in near future.

**WRESTLING:** Freestyle Wrestling was conducted in a disciplined manner and more are enthusiastic to participate in it and young talents are there in it. Greco-Roman Style Wrestling was not conducted as no sufficient and talented referee turned up; especially in Southern Area. We have no several young good wrestlers and we can hope for a much improved performance and ranking in the forthcoming Deaflympics.

Kerala retained “ **PRESIDENT OF INDIA SHIELD**” by retaining Overall Championship with 245 points and Senior Men, Junior and Sub Junior Boys Championship and went on to win Senior Women, Junior and Sub Juniors Girls Group Championship. West Bengal with 153 points was a distant runner-up in overall championship closely followed by Tamil Nadu with 139 points. Kerala's strength lied in Athletics, West Bengal depended on Athletics, Football and Table Tennis teams, Maharashtra on swimming teams, Tamil Nadu on Athletics and Basketball players.

The Closing Ceremony conducted on April 28, 2013 in the evening was very impressive and Prizes and Trophies were distributed to Winners and everybody enjoyed the grand finale of the Championship. Everybody felt that he/she contributed for the success of Championship and for the glory of Sport. The sportsmanship prevailed over everything else. Sri. Jeevan Sahay, General Manager, State Bank of India, Bengaluru, Sri. Nathalie Poirier, General Manager (Operations), Claire Foods & Beverages Pvt. Ltd., Sri. Jitendra Shetty, Dy. Director (Admn.), Dept. of Youth Services & Sports & Sri. Appachu, Joint Director, Dept. of Youth Services & Sports were guests in the closing ceremony.

The Hosts – Karnataka Sports Federation of the Deaf, Bengaluru had made elaborate arrangements for the Boarding and Lodging for the participants from April 24 to 29 afternoon 2013. It has also arranged a befitting transport system which made everybody to feel at home. Sri. Nanda Kumar K., Chairman and Sri. Balaji BA, Vice Chairman of Organising Committee extended their strength along with Mr. T. V. Manohar, Org. Secretary to make the National Games a great success after a gap of 15 years.

The Overall assessment of the XVIII National Games of the Deaf in respect of performance and turn-up of competitors is that progress of Sports and Games among the Deaf in the Country has continued up -word trend and that is the need and call of time.

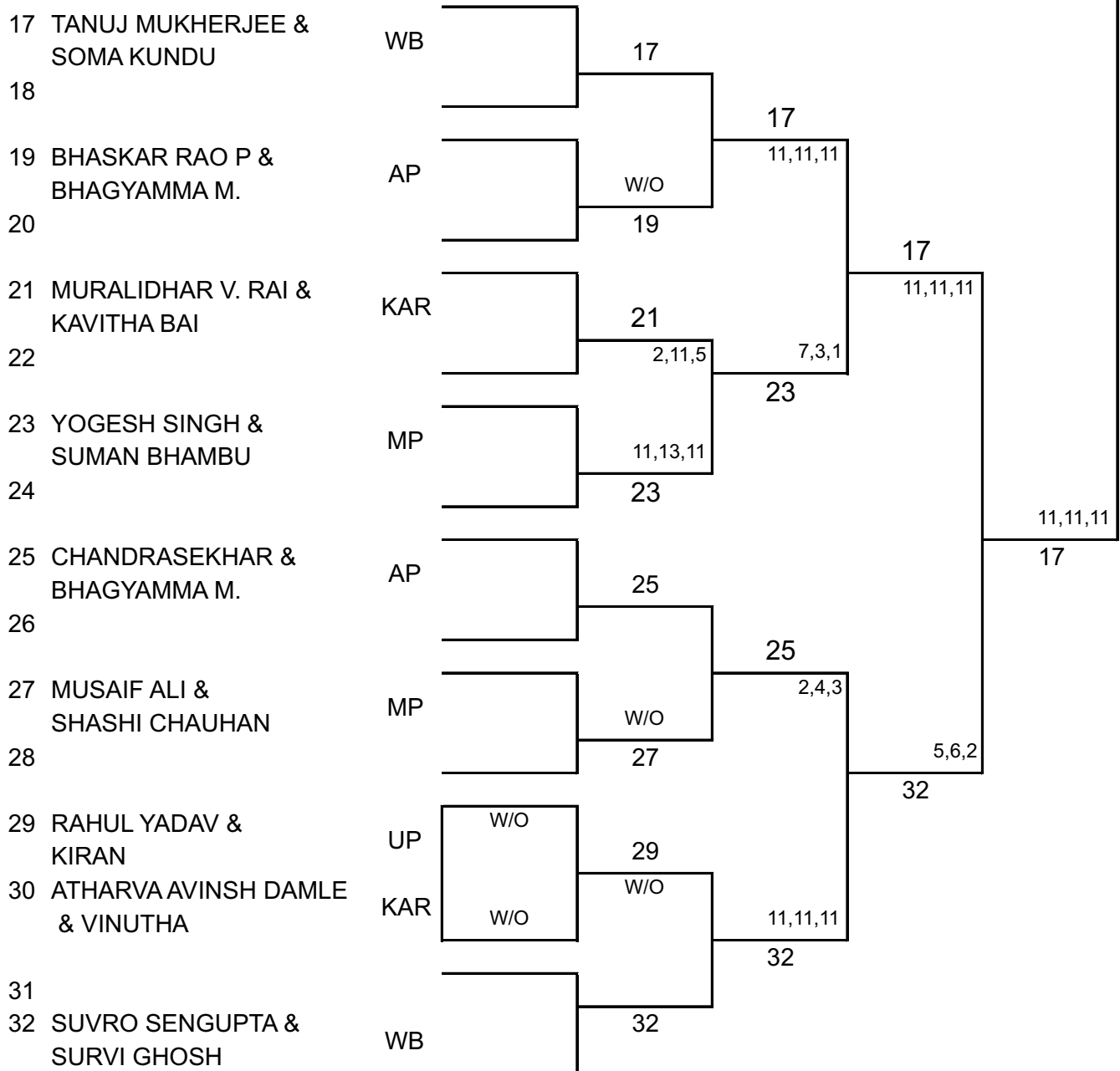
