Under the reference cited above, one post of **Young Professional (Accountant)** was included in the Approval ACTC for the Financial Year 2026-2027.

Accordingly, an advertisement for the post of Young Professional (Accountant) was published through various media platforms, newspapers, and the AISCD website. A total of 23 applications were received for the said post. After careful scrutiny, 13 candidates were found eligible and shortlisted for the interview process.

The interviews were conducted in two phases on **27 May 2026** and **28 May 2026**. Based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee, **Ms. Aashi Chauhan**, daughter of Shri. Kushal Pal Chauhan, residing at **H-11-A, Sector-11, Pratap Vihar, Ghaziabad - 201009**, has been selected and appointed as Young Professional (Accountant) at the Delhi Office of the All India Sports Council of the Deaf (AISCD).

She is appointed on the following terms and conditions. A consolidated remuneration of **Rs. 40,000/- (Rupees Forty Thousand only)** per month inclusive all, shall be reimbursed by the Sports Authority of India in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India, New Delhi.

Functions and Responsibilities of Young Professional (Accountant)

1. The Young Professional (Accountant) shall assist in preparing the annual accounts of the Federation and ensure timely submission to the Government. In the event of any anticipated delay, he/she shall promptly inform the Government, stating the reasons for such delay.

2. The Young Professional (Accountant) shall be responsible for:

- GST filing and compliance.
- Income Tax matters, including TDS and filing of returns.
- Coordination of internal and external audits.
- Preparation of grant and fund utilization reports.

3. The Young Professional (Accountant) shall also be responsible for:

- Maintaining books of accounts.
- Preparing financial statements and reports.
- Handling payments, receipts, and payroll functions.
- Budget planning and financial management for sports events.
- Ensuring compliance with GST, Income Tax and NGO Regulations
- Coordinating with auditors, banks and Government departments.

4. The Young Professional (Accountant) shall be responsible for the timely preparation and submission of Utilisation Certificates (UCs).

5. The Young Professional (Accountant) shall also be responsible for:

- CSR fund management.
- Monitoring and compliance related to Government schemes and grants, including Sports Authority of India funding.

6. The Young Professional (Accountant) may also be assigned administrative duties from time to time and shall visit the offices of the Sports Authority of India and other Government departments whenever required for official work.

7. Prior approval of the Government in the Department of Youth Affairs & Sports shall be obtained before terminating the services of the Young Professional (Accountant), if such termination is proposed before the expiry of the period for which assistance has been sanctioned by the Government.

8. Leave entitlement shall be governed by the rules applicable to Central Government employees, subject to the provisions and regulations of AISCD.
