- Section 9 of FC(R) Act, 1976, Provides inter-alia that no member of a legislature, 2. Sir,

Further to the Administrative Approval issued from File No.SAI/TD/ AISCD/F. Exp/2019-20/(542) dated 29th November, 2019 on the above mentioned subject, I am directed to convey the financial sanction of the Competent Authority, in principle, for the subject International Exposure, as per following break-up of financial assistance and Terms and Conditions:-

2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of the Competent Authority for the payment of a sum of Rs. 14,94,300/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakh Ninety Four Thousand Three Hundred Only) to the All India Sports Council of the Deaf as 75% advance grant to meet the expenditure on participation of team in the above mentioned event. The balance 25% grant will be released on receipt of Audited Accounts along with necessary vouchers/invoice duly certified by the Chartered Accountant and signed by the President of the Federation/ Association within one month after the event is over to Sports Authority of India in the enclosed formats.

- 3. The amount sanctioned herein will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer, Sports Authority of India on the prescribed bill immediately for disbursing the same to grantee through Electronic Clearing System. This grant is of non-recurring nature.
- 4. The grant is subject to the conditions mentioned below :-
 - (i) That the grantee shall execute a bond for the full amount of grant in the prescribed proforma on a non-judicial stamp paper in acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant duly executed by the authorized signatory of the grantee and two sureties and witnesses with complete permanent addresses.
 - (ii) The grantee shall maintain subsidiary accounts of the grant received from the Sports Authority of India.
 - (iii) The grantee shall maintain the register of assets in the prescribed form GFR-19. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned as per the procedure laid down in the General Financial Rules shall not be disposed off without the prior approval of the Sports Authority of India.
 - (iv) The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organizations and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant, for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will required to refund the entire amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum.
 - (v) The Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR 12 A disclosing whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized, were in fact reached and if not the reasons therefore should be submitted within six months of the completion of the programme along with the audited statement of accounts. The UC should be checked and signed by the Chartered Accountant with reference to the initial and subsidiary accounts of the grant to be maintained by the grantee as per GFRs.
 - (vi) The performance-cum-achievement report in respect of the above event for which the grant has been sanctioned should be forwarded to the TEAMS DIVISION, Sports Authority of India with a copy to Government Observer within one week of the completion of event.
 - (vii) That some photographs of the events, i.e. events, medal winners etc. with sample invitation cards for opening and closing ceremony and copies of newspaper clippings related to the event preferably in National and Regional dailies be sent to this office along with performance-cum-achievement report.
 - (viii) That the amount in INR will be subject to the actual rate of Foreign Exchange on the date of payment by the Federation. The difference, if any, in INR will be adjusted.
 - (ix) There is no reason to believe that the grantee is involved in corrupt practice.
 - (x) That no advertisement of Tobacco and Liquor will be displayed during the event, the breach of which entails the cancellation of grant.
 - (xi) Amount of grant should be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance of grant shall be refunded by the grantee institution immediately after conclusion of the event.
- (xii) The grantee should maintain separate accounts for the grants released by the Sports Authority of India. The accounts of the amount so paid to the grantee shall be open to check by an officer deputed by Sports Authority of India or the Government in addition to other statutory authorities to ensure proper utilization of the funds and that no profits are earned out this.

- (xiii) The grantee shall also submit consolidated accounts of the grants received from other Ministries/Departments/State Governments for detailed checking by the Sports Authority of India, in addition to the separate annual accounts on the activities implemented with the grants released by the Sports Authority of India.
- (xiv) The grant is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules as amended from time to time.
- (xv) The fact the programme is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Sports Authority of India should be prominently highlighted and displayed while inviting people and holding functions/programmes/events etc.
- (xvi) When the Sports Authority of India/Government of India/State Government has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved purposes, the payment of the grant will be stopped. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as mentioned in Clause IV above.
- (xvii) The grantee institution or organization should exercise reasonable economy in the working of the approved projects.
- (xviii) As per GFR-212(1), the accounts of grantee institution or organization shall be opened to inspection by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports/Sports Authority of India and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit of Sports Authority of India, New Delhi, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.
- 5. The above sanction has been issued under the powers delegated to the Director General/Secretary/Executive Director of Sports Authority of India. It is certified that the grant being released is in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- The amount of Rs. 14,94,300/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakh Ninety Four Thousand Three Hundred Only) shall be drawn and transferred to the All India Sports Council of the Deaf.
- 7. The amount of grant will be debitable to the Major Head 49.0500, Sub Head (**Assistance to National Sports Federations**) for the Financial Year 2019-2020.



PROBLEMS AND ISSUES FACED BY THE PARTICPANTS:

The main problem was with the sports kit provided to whole team. Because of our uniform we faced funny comments by players of other countries.

- 1. The uniform and sports kit provided was not as per he climate of the country. The temperature there was always below 0 degree with Snowfall and rain.
- The dress provided was not at all warm. The team was to be present always in the uniform which was not warm as per the climatic conditions.
- 2. The chess team was most of the time with a closed hall/ room but for SKIING team the uniform was not at all appropriate.

- 3. Skiing team was not provided appropriate skiing dress/ kit because of which they might have faced lot of problems but as told by the team Coach Mohd. Saleem participants of other countries helped them by sharing their sports kit. Coach decided to buy new kit for team but it was quite expensive.
- 4. Even after sharing all measurements and shoes size there were many complaints about Ceremonial dress and shoes provided.

Request is to kindly provide the uniform and sports kit as per the climate of the country and as per the sports participating.

CONCLUSION

This was the first time we participated in Winter games. Faced few difficulties and was a new experience. Hopefully next time the players will be well prepared to face all the adversities and we would win medals for our country.
